Learning Areas: After a client has completed a treatment program for some form of addiction or co-dependency and is continuing recovery through 12-step support groups, there are often still “*missing pieces*” in the client’s skill base regarding their most intimate relationships. Leading researchers in the field of marital counseling such as John and Julie Gottman have found that skill-based psycho-education can have a positive effect on the couple’s relationship as a part of a recovery process.

This presentation will enable mental health providers to:

- Identify the main goals of marital therapy, as part of the recovery process
- Assist couples in building marital friendship
- Help couples regulate conflicts in ways that nourish intimacy rather than cause distress or indifference
- And to explore ways to teach couples healthily and productive communication styles that compliment recovery
